Leaders Sharing Event Spring 2020

'Leaders' was the theme for our Spring Sharing with History and Geography as the main subject areas. We had exhibition style sharing in Years 3 and 4, and Skills Shares for Years 1, 2, 5 and 6.

Year 1 teamed up with **Year 5** in their Skills Share. Year 1 had been learning about two leaders of Art: Pieter Bruegel the Elder and L.S. Lowry. They taught Year 5 how to look for evidence to order paintings chronologically. Year 5 then shared their understanding of Anglo Saxons and Vikings and worked with Year 1 to compare aspects of law and order.







Year 2 and **Year 6** also had a go at being teachers and pupils. Year 2 had been learning about three nursing leaders: Mary Seacole, Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell. They showed Year clues about the lives of these great leaders. Year 6 then shared their knowledge of the UK using an atlas and Digimap online. It was good to see IT resources used so skilfully by pupils.





Year 3 were the experts in Ancient Egypt at their exhibition. They shared their work on the Pharaohs, the Leaders of Ancient Egypt. Visitors were then taught how to find evidence in pictures as Years 3 shared photos of artefacts from the tomb of Tutankhamun. There was a great variety of models and research work, completed as homework tasks.



Year 4 shared their knowledge and understanding of Ancient Rome in their exhibition, including work on the Roman Emperor Julius Caesar. The experts shared their historical knowledge of the volcanic eruption at Pompeii too. Model volcanoes of all sizes were on display showing how much pupils had enjoyed their homework tasks.
