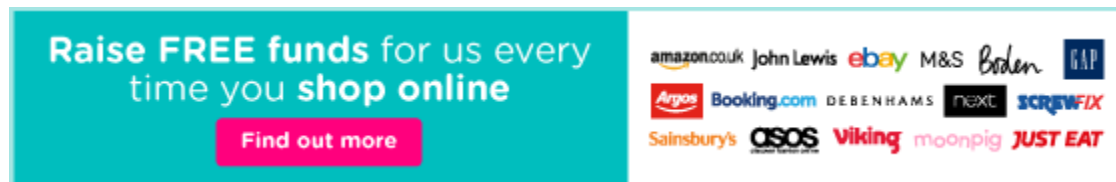
School PTA
